

AIRPORT SECURITY UNESCORTED ACCESS BADGE
FINGERPRINT APPLICATION FORM

TSR 1542.209 specifically prohibits unescorted access to the Security Identification Display Area (SIDA) to anyone convicted or found not guilty by reason of insanity, in any jurisdiction during the past 10 years, of any of the following crimes:

1. Forgery of Certificates, false marking of aircraft, and other aircraft violation
2. Interference with air navigation
3. Improper transportation of a hazardous material
4. Aircraft piracy
5. Interference with flight crew members or flight attendants
6. Commission of certain crimes aboard aircraft in flight
7. Carrying a weapon or explosive aboard aircraft
8. Conveying false information and threats
9. Aircraft piracy outside the special aircraft jurisdiction of the United States
10. Lighting violations involving transporting controlled substances
11. Unlawful entry into an aircraft or airport area that serves air carriers or foreign air carriers contrary to established security requirements
12. Destruction of an aircraft or aircraft facility
13. Murder
14. Assault with intent to murder
15. Espionage
16. Sedition
17. Kidnapping or hostage taking
18. Treason
19. Rape or aggravated sexual abuse
20. Unlawful possession, use, sale, distribution, or manufacture of an explosive or weapon
21. Extortion
22. Armed or felony unarmed robbery
23. Distribution of, intent to distribute, a controlled substance
24. Felony, arson
25. Felony involving a threat
26. Felony involving-
 - (i) Willful destruction of property;
 - (ii) Importation or manufacture of a controlled substance;
 - (iii) Burglary;
 - (iv) Theft;
 - (v) Dishonesty, fraud, or misrepresentation;
 - (vi) Possession or distribution of stolen property;
 - (vii) Aggravated assault;
 - (viii) Bribery; or
 - (ix) Illegal possession of a controlled substance punishable by a maximum of more than 1 year.

28. Conspiracy or attempt to commit any of the criminal acts listed in this paragraph.
