

REPORT TO THE 2026 LEGISLATURE

**AS REQUIRED BY ACT 57,
SESSION LAWS OF HAWAII 2019**

**Department of Human Resources Development
December 2025**

Background

The Department of Human Resources Development's (DHRD) mission is to provide timely and responsive leadership, resources, and services to fully support the State of Hawai'i in the recruitment, management, and retention of a high-performing workforce based on the merit principle as defined by [HRS §76-1](#).

Act 57, Session Laws of Hawai'i 2019, as amended by Act 151, Session Laws of Hawai'i 2023, states the Director of the Department of Human Resources Development shall:

1. Facilitate and expedite the hiring and recruitment for civil service positions under the jurisdiction of the department of human resources development; and
2. Have the authority to reclassify and abolish vacant positions within state departments and agencies that are under the jurisdiction of the department of human resources development, subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Prior to reclassifying or abolishing any vacant position as provided under this paragraph, the director shall submit a report to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to each regular session. The report shall include a list of vacant positions for reclassification or abolishment, identify the agency each position is attached to, provide reasons for reclassifying or abolishing the position, and state the duration the position has been vacant; and
 - b. The director may reclassify or abolish any vacant position as provided under this paragraph no earlier than sixty days after the report has been submitted to the legislature as provided under this paragraph.

The inaugural report was submitted to the 2020 Legislature. No actions were taken to reclassify or abolish any positions in that report to establish a baseline assessment of the current situation and challenges among departments in the State of Hawai'i Executive Branch.

In the years since the inception of the Annual Report on Vacancies, DHRD has identified numerous stagnant positions to be abolished using various parameters (10 years, 5 years, then 4 years vacant). In the 2025 annual report, DHRD did not make any recommendations, but identified 419 civil service positions that had been vacant for four years or more.

In July 2025, each Executive Branch department was provided with a list of their vacant positions that have remained unfilled for more than four years. Departments were requested to update and clean up their human resources management system data, making sure positions are removed if they had been abolished, if the NTE date had

passed, etc., and were allowed to explain the reasoning for the length of vacancy. For this year's report, 485 civil service positions have been vacant for four years or more, as of November 1, 2025.

Civil Service Vacancy Statistics

DHRD continues to recruit and screen applications for the Executive Branch agencies and to assist them with filling their department vacancies. Table 2 provides the recent years' vacancy data for the Executive Branch.

Even though the vacancy rate remained the same as in 2024, at 24%, the total number of civil service positions active in the human resources management system (HRMS) increased by 485 positions over the last year. Without the additional 485 positions, the overall vacancy rate would have dropped to 22%. It is also important to note that the number of filled civil service positions has increased by nearly 300, meaning that departments' hiring has kept pace with separations and then some. Since DHRD has no control over the number of authorized new positions, it is important to consider several data points. Maintaining the same vacancy rate means DHRD and the executive branch

departments made great strides recruiting new employees and filling vacancies in the last year.

Table 3 identifies civil service vacancies by department, including a comparison of the previous two years' vacancies. Table 3 represents true civil service positions and does not include seasonal or surge positions.

DHRD averages about 500 open recruitments on any given day. In the last year, the DHRD Employee Staffing Division's (ESD) Recruitment, Certification and Examination employees conducted slightly less recruitments compared to the previous fiscal year but received and screened more applications than the previous year.

- Civil service recruitments decreased 2%, from 712 to 695;
- Applications received surged 27%, from 30,131 to 41,570;
- Applications screened jumped 31%, from 25,217 to 36,454
- Certified lists issued to departments increased 1%, from 4,503 to 4,568; and
- Qualified eligibles referred to departments grew 3%, 52,370 to 53,837.

DHRD referred more than 53,000 qualified applications (some applicants were referred to more than one job vacancy) in one year, as has been the trend since the end of the pandemic. After receiving 53,000 eligible candidates, departments filled 80% of requisitions, up from 67% last year. Requests to fill decreased by 8%, from 1,435 to 1,325, with the number of new hires filling positions rising 9%, from 969 to 1,070.

The increase in eligible candidates does not directly correlate with improved vacancy filling rates, suggesting that departments may be facing challenges in selecting suitable candidates or that job descriptions are not aligned with the available talent pool.

As expected, the sheer volume of applications received and requests to fill vacancies have kept DHRD recruitment staff extremely busy. DHRD is still working to return to pre-pandemic staffing levels, training new employees, and making strides in decreasing screening time from 61 days in FY24 to 38 days in FY25.

Non-Civil Service (Exempt) Vacancy Statistics

In addition to civil service classes, departments are delegated responsibility to establish and fill positions that are exempt from civil service, pursuant to HRS §76-16. Table 4 provides data on departments exempt position counts and their vacancy rate as of November 1, 2025.

Vacancies by Class of Work in Executive Branch

The high number of vacant positions in the State of Hawai‘i presents several critical challenges and opportunities for improving workforce management and service delivery. Table 5 identifies the highest number of vacancies by class of work as of November 1, 2025.

The classes of work are combined for all levels. For example, Office Assistant (OA) total vacancies include counts for OA II, III, IV and V levels. If an applicant applied for and was qualified at multiple levels, they are counted at each level for which they are qualified. Additionally, there are often multiple recruitments per year. If an applicant applies more than once for the same level and meets the minimum qualification requirements, they are counted each time they apply and are deemed qualified.


Statewide Employee Movement

DHRD tracks the movements of employees in, within, or out of a department. Each “move out” creates a vacancy within the State workforce.

- Moves Within Department are transfers or promotions to permanent civil service positions. This also includes movements from temporary/exempt/89-day hire appointments into permanent, civil service positions.
- Moves Out of Department means the employee moved to a different position in a different department.
- Retirements are self-explanatory but include reasons such as Voluntary Retirement (428) and Ordinary Disability (8).
- Terminations include both voluntary and in-voluntary terminations, including individuals who have left State government for other opportunities. The most common reasons for leaving include Personal Reasons (225), Other Reasons/Unknown (195), Other Employment Private (75), Other Jurisdiction (68), Discharge (60), Accept Exempt Position (30), Death (25), Work for City & County of Honolulu (15), and Health Reasons (8).

Table 6 shows the statewide count of the various types of moves out from FY17 through FY25 for all Executive Branch departments, excluding the Department of Education and University of Hawai‘i.

Table 6: Statewide Types of Turnover and Moves Out from FY17 – FY25




Of the 1,169 individuals who left State employment through termination or retirement in FY25, zero individuals reported dissatisfaction with their pay or hours, and four people indicated dissatisfaction with their supervisor. A detailed breakout of the explanation of reasons that employees left state government can be found in Appendix B.

State employees often transfer to a different department for professional growth or a higher paying position. The movements in Table 7 fill a vacancy and show the statewide total of types of moves into a department, either from the same or different department, and new hires from FY17 to FY25.

The substantial dip in FY21 is attributed to the hiring freeze for funded civil service positions imposed by Governor David Ige, which was in place from April 2020 through July 2021, per [Executive Memorandum 20-01](#).

For the second year in a row, the State has seen a net increase in positions being filled. The breakout of moves in and out by department can be found in Appendix C. In FY25, the data reflects a notable increase in external hires compared to internal, indicating that departments are expanding their teams through external recruitment rather than relying solely on internal mobility. This approach brings in fresh perspectives and specialized expertise to support evolving organizational needs.

Retirement Projections

DHRD's annual State of Hawai'i Workforce Profile Report submitted to the Legislature each year projects the eligible retirements for the executive branch workforce over the next five fiscal years. Table 8 provides the details and breakout of retirement projections for the executive branch.

The projected retirement eligibility of nearly 30% of the executive branch workforce by FY30 presents a significant strategic risk to the continuity of government operations. Several departments are particularly vulnerable, with over one-third of their workforce eligible to retire. This trend underscores the urgent need for proactive workforce planning to mitigate the loss of institutional knowledge and ensure uninterrupted delivery of essential public services.

While the scale of projected retirements poses challenges, it also presents a unique opportunity to reshape and modernize the State workforce. As long-serving employees transition out, departments can recruit new talent equipped with contemporary skills in technology, data analysis, and community engagement. This generational shift offers a chance to enhance diversity, equity, and inclusion across state agencies, and to align workforce capabilities with evolving public expectations and service delivery models.

State Employee Turnover Rates

DHRD did a 5-year look back at employee turnover, comparing retirement and termination numbers to total employee count to determine the State's turnover rate. The State's turnover rate has been decreasing since FY222 and has ranged from a low of 8.50% to a high of 11.15% as shown in Table 9. Data in Appendix B highlights the reasons individuals leave State employment, most notably for voluntary retirement and personal reasons. The data collected is voluntary and contingent on the employee sharing their reason(s) and by the department human resources offices recording the information.



Table 10 breaks down the turnover rate by department. In FY25, the turnover rate decreased to 9.54%. The departments with the highest turnover are the Departments of the Attorney General (ATG), Commerce & Consumer Affairs (CCA), and Defense (DEF).

Operation Hire Hawai'i & Federal Employees Hired

Operation Hire Hawai'i (OHHI) aligns with [Executive Order 25-02](#) by Governor Josh Green, M.D., to prioritize the recruitment of highly skilled professionals to address critical workforce needs across Hawai'i's public sector.

Since launching OHHI in February 2025, DHRD has received 246 requisitions from departments requesting to fill their vacancies using this method. Each requisition can be used for one vacancy or for group hire to fill multiple vacancies. For example, the Department of the Attorney General used one requisition to hire 12 Legal Assistants and another requisition to hire 12 Office Assistant IVs.

DHRD's Employee Staffing Division (ESD) has opened a total of 168 recruitments under OHHI. Over 7,700 applications have been submitted by individuals looking for employment with the State of Hawai'i.

The executive branch departments have also been tracking the number of new hires through all hiring programs, not just OHHI, who's most recent experience was with the federal government. Table 11 shows the number of hires under the OHHI recruitment process and the number of federal hires for each department as of December 1, 2025.

Recruitment Strategies

With Hawai'i facing an unprecedented labor shortage and to address vacancy issues, the State Recruiting Office has utilized different strategies to attract prospective candidates to State employment. The following outlines a few of the methods focused on this year:

Outreach/Marketing

The DHRD Recruiting Office has continued its partnership with Consolidated Theatres in 2025, running a 45-week recruitment campaign. 30-second promotional videos were presented 2-3 times before every movie at various locations, including Kāhala, Ward, Pearlridge West, Mililani Cinema 14, 'Olino by Consolidated Theatres, and Kapolei Theatres. The two recruitment videos, created by DHRD staff, featured State employees from diverse career groups, such as blue collar/trades, office administration, information technology, law enforcement, and health services.

In addition to the Consolidated Theatres campaign, DHRD continued its advertising contracts with the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa Athletics and Hawai'i's Network of Malls in 2025. The contract with UH Mānoa Athletics provided visibility for recruitment at the Stan Sheriff Center during all men's and women's volleyball and basketball games throughout the 2024-25 school year, targeting approximately 75,000 residents and students.

Furthermore, a one-year contract with Hawai'i Network of Malls allowed DHRD to place print advertisements in 16 shopping malls and centers, reaching an average of 2.2 million shoppers each month through August 2025. Overall, DHRD will continue to seek new opportunities to expand its marketing and branding efforts.

NEOGOV Attract

DHRD began piloting a new feature of NEOGOV (the State's recruitment and onboarding platform) in April 2025 with full implementation in Fall 2025. Attract allows DHRD to manage outreach efforts with candidates, automated communication and measures recruitment data. DHRD uses the system to conduct pre-registration of interested candidates before an event, manage registration of attendees at recruitment events, send automated emails, monitor the progress of each prospective candidate through the application process to a permanent position.

Campaign Tracking



At the CORE event in Wahiawā in November 2025, Attract was used to pre-register attendees, register participants at the event, and provide feedback on the event.

98 individuals pre-registered their intent to attend the recruitment event and 191 registered upon arriving at the event. 18 individuals took the time to submit feedback: 52.6% gave DHRD 5 out of 5 and 31.6% gave DHRD 4 out of 5 for the event overall. 94.4% intend to browse jobs on DHRD's website and 50% intend to apply for a State civil service job.

As the team is still learning the ins and outs of Attract, DHRD looks forward to utilizing it to its fullest potential in helping with recruitment.

LinkedIn

Throughout 2025, DHRD has actively leveraged social media platforms like Facebook, Instagram, and LinkedIn to promote State recruitments and job fair initiatives. In February 2025, DHRD signed a one-year contract with LinkedIn to utilize their Talent Solutions services, which includes career pages to showcase the executive branch and job postings, as well as an automated job wrapping process that streamlines and accelerates job listings.

In 2025, LinkedIn had 23,296 views of job postings. The posted jobs generated 3,553 apply starter leads which takes an applicant from LinkedIn to DHRD's website to apply. There were 53 confirmed hires through LinkedIn, where a person lists an end date at their previous company (on their LinkedIn profile) and a start date for a position with the State of Hawai'i. This in no way measures all hires who got to the DHRD website through LinkedIn.

Targeted Recruitment and Job Fairs

Recognizing the competitive job market, DHRD emphasizes the importance of maintaining a strong presence at various career fairs and outreach events to engage directly with potential applicants. The State Recruiting Office collaborates with agencies to represent job opportunities and employee benefits effectively. In 2025, DHRD participated in 44 recruitment events, including career fairs at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa, the University of Hawai'i West O'ahu, Chaminade University, and Hawai'i

Pacific University, which facilitated connections with college graduates, and informational workshops for Hele Imua interns and potential applicants at the State Capitol. DHRD also coordinated participation in four public events organized by the Star Advertiser at the Neil Blaisdell Center.

To further enhance recruitment efforts, DHRD hosted four targeted fast-track recruitment events aimed at expediting the application and screening process. These events allowed DHRD to pilot new procedures, including on-site application acceptance for roles such as Office Assistant (3 times), Biosecurity Inspector, Environmental Health Specialist, Human Resources Specialist, and Professional Trainee, as well as on-site screening and interviews. A total of 605 applications were received during these events, with 429 individuals qualified, 496 interviews scheduled, and 39 individuals hired to date by participating departments. DHRD continues to collaborate with counterparts on the neighbor islands to participate in local events, assisting in filling State vacancies across the islands.

SkillBridge

In July 2024, DHRD's application was approved by the U.S. Department of Defense's SkillBridge program on behalf of the State of Hawai'i. SkillBridge creates a partnership between employers and current active-duty service members and provides the service member an opportunity to receive specific training or participate in an internship or apprenticeship with an employer during their last three to six months of their military service. This program assists the service members with transitioning to civilian life and will provide training or experience, with the hope that the service members will apply for a vacant position upon retirement or separation.

DHRD initially focused on IT positions and has since expanded our opportunities to include Account Clerks, Building Maintenance Workers, Office Assistants, and Registered Nurses, with more classes to be added in the future.

DHRD has received 74 inquiries from service members interested in the SkillBridge internship. DHRD's first success story was one service member who did their internship at DHRD and was subsequently hired into the executive branch. Three other service members have been placed with departments and are in the pipeline to start their internships. DHRD has been working with various departments to identify department specific classes of work that will benefit from SkillBridge and will continue to collaborate with the managers to secure more partnerships. Additional resources would be necessary to expand this program.

Hele Imua State of Hawai'i Internship Program

Since its inception in September 2022, the Hele Imua State of Hawai'i Internship Program has seen significant developments, particularly following the memorandum of agreement signed between DHRD and DLIR in September 2023. This agreement formalizes the support that DHRD will provide to the internship program. As part of this collaboration, DLIR has assigned an exempt Workforce Program Specialist to DHRD to assist with the internship program and support the interns directly.

The Workforce Program Specialist began working with DHRD in November 2023, taking on the responsibility of coordinating programs and developing a five-course curriculum

specifically for the Hele Imua interns. The primary goal of the internship is to equip interns with quality work experience, preparing them for careers in their chosen field. This structured approach aims to enhance the interns' employability and better prepare them for future opportunities within state government and beyond. The program includes:

- 1) Hele Imua Meet and Greet – Scheduled bi-monthly or individually if interns are unable to attend regularly scheduled session. This session is essential as it provides guidance on the learning management system, their intern learning plan, and specifics about the in-person trainings, focused on the application, interview, and placement process. 151 interns attended 17 sessions between January 2025 and October 2025. Meetings will continue twice a month for the remainder of the calendar year.
- 2) Hele Imua In-Person – This all-day session covers resume creation/refreshment, NEOGOV and the State's application process, and an interviewing process workshop. 96 interns have attended 4 sessions so far in 2025 and there is one more session scheduled in December 2025.
- 3) Hele Imua Recruitment Workshop – Hands-on workshop with the intern and a DHRD recruiter, exploring positions for which the intern would qualify. 38 interns attended four sessions in 2025 and one more class is scheduled for November 2025.
- 4) Hele Imua Open House – A networking event for current interns where former interns, now employees, hosted a round-table discussion on their experiences, and a Legislator Q&A session. Two events were held in 2025.
- 5) Hele Imua Learning Path – Compilation of approximately 23 online/on-demand training courses for all interns including an overview of State government, Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) Training and Workplace Violence Program training. 164 interns were enrolled in 2024.

In 2025, approximately 40 interns accepted permanent positions. Although this total number seems low, there were considerable numbers of interns hired per hiring period that were unavailable or not interested in pursuing full-time work at the State at that time (i.e. not yet graduated).

As DLIR is the hiring agency for this program, DHRD defers to them for updated statistics.

Classification & Compensation Study

In 2025, the Legislature passed SB1567 and Governor Green signed into law Act 180 which requires the Department of Human Resources Development to complete a comprehensive review of the classification and compensation systems for all civil service positions under its jurisdiction. This study will help DHRD effectively address antiquated class specifications, class titles, and minimum qualification requirements, and identify and develop recommendations to ensure wages remain competitive and that pay programs keep pace with market changes. The Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued on October 3, 2025, and closed on November 7, 2025. Proposals were reviewed and a contractor has been selected. The department is currently working with the selected vendor on finalizing a contract. As part of this effort, DHRD is requiring the

contractor to recommend technological solutions, including associated costs and estimated implementation timelines, to improve the efficiency and accuracy of the State's classification and compensation management processes. These recommendations are intended to ensure that any proposed system reforms are supported by modern tools capable of sustaining long-term improvements and reducing reliance on manual, labor-intensive workflows.

Classification Updates

DHRD recently worked closely with the Department of Agriculture and Biosecurity to review, retitle, and revise the minimum qualifications for the Biosecurity Inspector (formerly Plant Quarantine Inspector) series with the goal of broadening the education requirements. DHRD anticipated that these amendments to the MQs will allow for more qualified applicants to be considered in filling the numerous vacancies within the department.

Classification also updated the minimum qualifications for the following classes: Natural Resources Management Specialist, Park Caretaker I & II, State Airports Fire Chief, Foster Grandparent Program Manager, and Farm Manager I.

The upcoming Classification and Compensation Study is intended to review and make recommendations on improving the State's classification system, including MQs.

Compensation Updates

Architect Salary Schedule


Similar to the Engineer Salary Schedule developed in 2024, a separate Architect Salary Schedule was developed to aid in the recruitment and retention of employees in the series. The higher rates on the new salary schedule eliminates the need for shortage differentials and has resulted in a more competitive salary schedule.

Increased Use of Pay Programs

Pay programs used to address recruitment challenges, retention, and recognize increased competencies such as Flexible Hiring Rates and the Excluded Managerial Compensation Plan (EMCP) Pay Programs have experienced an upward trend in usage over the years, except during the COVID period in FY 2021. Over the past five years, total use has increased by 93%.

Conclusion

There have been persistent challenges and significant progress made in addressing workforce gaps across the State of Hawai'i Executive Branch. While the overall civil service vacancy rate remained steady at 24%, the total number of filled positions increased by nearly 300 over the last year, indicating that departments are actively expanding their capacity to meet public service demands. Notably, the number of new hires rose by 9% and the percentage of filled requisitions improved from 67% to 80%, demonstrating the effectiveness of enhanced recruitment strategies and interdepartmental collaboration.

Despite these gains, there are critical areas requiring continued attention. High vacancy rates in key classifications such as Office Assistants, Adult Correctional Officers, and Human Services Professionals underscore the continued need for dedicated resources, targeted recruitment initiatives, and streamlined hiring processes. The projected retirement eligibility of nearly 30% of the workforce by FY2030 further emphasizes the urgency of succession planning and knowledge transfer initiatives.

Programs like Operation Hire Hawai'i and the Hele Imua Internship Program have shown promise in attracting new talent and diversifying the State workforce. Additionally, the increased use of flexible hiring rates and pay programs reflects a growing commitment to modernizing the State's approach to workforce management.

As DHRD continues to implement the mandates of Act 180 and prepares for a comprehensive classification and compensation study, the department remains focused on building a resilient, high-performing public workforce. Continued collaboration with departments, data-driven decision-making, and sustained investment in recruitment and retention will be essential to meeting the evolving needs of Hawai'i's residents.

Types of Moves Out of Department (Creates a Vacancy)




Types of Moves Into Department (Fills a Vacancy)



Types of Moves Out of Department (Creates a Vacancy)




Types of Moves Into Department (Fills a Vacancy)



Types of Moves Out of Department (Creates a Vacancy)




Types of Moves Into Department (Fills a Vacancy)



Types of Moves Out of Department (Creates a Vacancy)





Types of Moves Into Department (Fills a Vacancy)







Types of Moves Out of Department (Creates a Vacancy)




Types of Moves Into Department (Fills a Vacancy)



Types of Moves Out of Department (Creates a Vacancy)




Types of Moves Into Department (Fills a Vacancy)




DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION (TAX)

Types of Moves Out of Department (Creates a Vacancy)




Types of Moves Into Department (Fills a Vacancy)




DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TRN)

Types of Moves Out of Department (Creates a Vacancy)




Types of Moves Into Department (Fills a Vacancy)
